We are seeking to appoint a dynamic and outstanding teacher to lead our Mathematics Faculty. The successful applicant will have excellent interpersonal skills and a thorough knowledge of NESA Teaching and Educational Standards requirements.

The Learning Leader's position focuses on curriculum leadership, participating in delivering the vision of Wyong Christian Community School focusing on developing the quality of teaching and learning, and nurturing positive relationships between students, teachers and stakeholders. The successful candidate will be a person who can confidently lead teachers to engage and motivate students to achieve success in their study of mathematics.

The Learning Leader:

- in collaboration with the Heads of Secondary, provides educational leadership in the school and the community by developing and promoting the school vision and encouraging school staff to share ownership of the school's vision and goals;
- provides professional leadership to all members of the faculty, and provides up-to-date information on relevant specialist curriculum issues;
- facilitates teaching and learning outcomes through effective performance management and modelling and promoting a culture of improvement;
- establishes and manages administrative and operational systems in the faculty in order to ensure its effective operation;
- ensures the mathematics curriculum is delivered from a biblical worldview;
- ensures effective programs, and teaching and learning experiences are compliant with NESA requirements at all times.
- monitors the differentiation of programs for students with particular needs, through extra support or opportunities for extension;
- monitors the corporate performance of the mathematics faculty and provide regular feedback and, where necessary, in consultation with the Head of Secondary Teaching and Learning, subsequent action in relation to this;
- manages the annual faculty budget and plans and develops appropriate resources to ensure an effective department;
- encourages the ongoing professional development of staff to ensure high quality teaching and learning;
- meets regularly with the Head of Secondary School Teaching and Learning and other Learning Leaders to ensure the effective running of the faculty.

Selection Criteria:

- Successful candidate will affirm a personal belief in the school's **Statement of Faith** as accessible on the school website as well as active involvement within their local church.
- Demonstrated high level of understanding of the NSW Curriculum and Australian Professional Standards for Teachers and the capacity to provide leadership in the alignment of these areas.
- Demonstrated outstanding classroom teaching skills and the capacity to coach and support colleagues to continually improve teaching and learning.
- Demonstrated ability to monitor and assess student learning data at the individual, cohort and whole school level and to use this data to inform teaching for improved student learning.
- Demonstrated high level written and verbal communication skills and high-level interpersonal skills including a capacity to develop constructive relationships with students, parents and other staff.
- Successful teaching experience with capacity to initiate improvement in teaching, learning and classroom practice.
- Knowledge of curriculum and assessment with the ability to lead and design quality, inclusive teaching and learning programs.
- Educational leadership skills to build the capacity and manage the performance of individuals and teams.
- Ability to plan and manage resources effectively and equitably to support teaching and learning.
