Fees are due one term in advance, payable in the last week of the preceding term.

FEE DUE DATES

Term 1 Fees, 2023 are due and payable by the 8th December 2022.

Term 2 Fees, 2023 are due and payable by the 6th April 2023.

Term 3 Fees, 2023 are due and payable by the 30th June 2023.

Term 4 Fees, 2023 are due and payable by the 22nd September 2023.

Please note: Students electing to attend a **TVET or Online course** will incur additional charges.

TVET & EXTERNAL COURSES

- **Years 9 & 10 External Courses:** Parents / Guardians are responsible to pay the full fee of any external course taken by a Year 9 or Year 10 Student. The fees will be charged separately by the School.
- **Years 11 & 12 External Courses:** Parents / Guardians are responsible to pay the full fee up front for the Year 11 Online Course. Wyong Christian Community School will then cover the Year 12 Online Course fees in the following year. These fees vary depending on the course selected.
- **Registration: for any external courses will be dependent on all School fees being paid in advance.**
- **Year 12 Fees:** Are spread over the four terms in 2023, so please be aware that you will be **billed for four terms.**
- **TVET Courses:** Parents / Guardian are responsible for their portion of the fees incurred each year of the course. Both the Government and the School contribute to the cost of the course, the Government in 2022 paid \$600 and the School contributed \$500, the remaining balance being paid by the family. Please note that the bill for these courses comes through to the school in late October each year, so payment will be required by November.

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS

Parents should note that the School Policy states "that parents are required to give the School, a full term's notice in writing, of the intention to withdraw a student/s. **Failure to give such notice will incur a full term's fees**".

PERSONAL LAPTOP PROGRAM PLP - SECONDARY STUDENTS 7-12

In order to enhance the learning environment for our students, we have introduced a PLP Program. Students in Secondary School are encouraged to take part in the scheme. The uptake of laptops for Year 7, 2022 has been significant, with close to 80% of families participating in the program.
